General Rules

1. The organisers reserve the right to cancel, amalgamate and divide classes where necessary to facilitate the running of the event.
2. No refunds will be given, except at the discretion of the organisers.
3. **The Judge's decision will be final.**
4. **INSURANCE:** Please note: non BRC members are not covered by the BRC insurance policy. It is mandatory for anyone attending this event to have public liability (3rd party) insurance. [By entering you confirm that you hold appropriate public liability insurance.](#)
5. **Anyone aged 17 years or under** must be accompanied by an adult who takes full responsibility for their welfare and actions at all times while on site.
6. Only those named at time of entry may ride or exhibit horses / ponies at the Show.
7. **It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that when mounted they are wearing a hard hat conforming to current British Riding Clubs rules.**
8. Anyone using a mobile phone in the ring will be asked to leave immediately.
9. **Horses and Ponies must only be ridden at walk outwith warm-up or rings.** Organisers will request the immediate removal of any animal not under control. Stallions or colts must not be led or ridden by any one under the age of 14. Stallions must be identified by a red, white and blue ribbon in the tail.
10. The ages of horses will be calculated from 1st January in the year in which they were foaled. **All horses and ponies shown under saddle to be four years old and over.**
11. All ponies shown in the Mountain and Moorland classes must be shown in accordance with the breed societies regulations. The M&M classes are open to registered and non-registered animals.
12. Exhibitors are required to withdraw from a class if the Judge has an interest in his/her exhibit (owned, trained, kept at livery, ridden in competition, financial interest or similar).

13. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times. Please scoop the poop.
14. Any objections against the awards of the Judges (which on the merits of each exhibit shall be final - see Rule 3), or in regard to any matter connected with the Show, must be lodged in writing, with the Secretary, not later than 12 noon on the day following the Show. Each protest must be accompanied by a deposit of £25, and if not upheld the sum deposited may, at the discretion of the Committee, be forfeited to the Club. All decisions of the Committee shall be final in determining the outcome.

JUDGING COMMENCES AT 10 AM in both Rings.

RING 1 Judge: Mr D Richmond, Dalrymple, Ayrshire

Class 1 Best Turned Out Horse - including Cobs, Coloureds, etc - in hand or ridden.

Class 2 Cob - Ridden - four years old or over.

Class 3 Coloured - Traditional / Native - Ridden - four years old and over.

Class 4 Coloured - Sports / Plaited - Ridden - four years old and over.

Class 5 Cob - In Hand - any age.

Class 6 Coloured - Traditional / Native - In Hand - any age.

Class 7 Coloured - Sports / Plaited - In Hand - any age.

SINGLETONS SHATTON SOPHIE MEMORIAL TROPHY for best cob from winners of Classes 2 & 5.

ZEBADEE TROPHY for Best Coloured from winners of Classes 3, 4, 6 and 7.

Class 8 Novice Horse - Ridden. Walk and Trot only. Snaffle bit, no spurs or whips. Entries in this class may not enter any other ridden class.

Class 9 Veteran Horse / Pony (16 years and over) - Ridden.

Special Rosette awarded for highest placed veteran over 20 years.

Class 10 Ex Racehorse - mare or gelding, 4 years old or over - ridden.

Class 11 Any other type / breed of Horse / Pony (Arab, Friesian, Palomino, etc) - ridden.

Class 12 Veteran Horse / Pony (16 years and over) - In Hand.

Class 13 Any other type / breed of Horse / Pony (Arab, Friesian, Palomino, etc) - In Hand.

Class 14 Riding Horse, mare or gelding, 4 years old or over - ridden.

Class 15 'Lightweight' Hunter mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, capable of carrying 79.5 kg (12 stone 7 lb) and under. Small Hunters to be included in this category.

Class 16 'Heavyweight' Hunter Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, capable of carrying over 79.5 kg (12 stone 7 lb). Middleweight Hunters to be included in this category.

CHAMPIONSHIP - To be judged from 1st prize winners in classes 1 - 16. CO-OPERATIVE TROPHY

Qualifier for the Caledonian Showing Championships.



This show is a qualifier for the Caledonian Showing Championships, which offers competitors the opportunity to compete at a top level Championship Final in Scotland. With a draped main arena, amazing rosettes, special prizes, music, judges from the south and atmospheric Evening Performances, this is the show everyone wants to be part of.

This year's show will be held at Highfield @ Howe, near Ladybank, Fife on 16/17 October 2021.

Every horse & pony placed 1st and 2nd in all In hand, Ridden Showing classes (not fun classes) & Working Hunter/Pony classes will qualify to compete in any appropriate class at the Finals. All Champions & Reserves will qualify for the Champion & Reserves Stakes Finals. Qualification will be from placings, no qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, and no qualification can go down the line.

All qualified horses and ponies will be listed on the Caledonian Showing Championship Show's website www.caledonianchampionships.webs.com (and soon to come www.caledonianchampionships.co.uk) where you will also find a regularly updated list of qualifying shows and a wealth of other information.

RING 2

Class 17 Brood Mare with foal at foot or having a foal in 2021 - to be shown in hand.

Class 18 Foal - to be shown in hand.

Class 19 Yearling colt, filly or gelding - to be shown in hand.

Class 20 2 year old colt, filly or gelding - to be shown in hand.

Class 21 3 year old colt, filly or gelding - to be shown in hand.

CKHDT TROPHY for best yearling, two or three year old.

Class 22 Best Turned Out Pony / M&M - in hand or ridden.

Class 23 Mountain and Moorland Small Breeds - to be shown ridden. (*Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A and B, Eriskay.*)

Class 24 Mountain & Moorland Large Breeds - to be shown ridden. (*Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C & D.*)

Class 25 Lead Rein Pony - mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128 cm (12.2 hh). Rider 10 years and under. Snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to noseband only.

Class 26 First Ridden Pony - mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128 cm. Rider 12 years and under. Snaffle bridle.

Class 27 Mountain and Moorland Small Breeds - Any age - to be shown in hand. (*Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A and B, Eriskay.*)

Class 28 Mountain & Moorland Large Breeds - Any age - to be shown in hand. (*Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C & D.*)

TERREGLES STUD TROPHY for Best Shetland (Standard or Miniature) (Classes 23 & 27).

Class 29 Novice Pony - Ridden. Walk and Trot only. Snaffle bit, no spurs or whips. Entries in this class may not enter any other ridden class.

Class 30 Show Pony - mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 138 cm (13.2hh). Rider 14 years and under.

Class 31 Show Pony - mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 148 cm (14.2hh). Rider 16 years and under.

Class 32 Ridden Show Hunter Pony - mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133 cm (13 hh). Rider 16 years and under.

Class 33 Ridden Show Hunter Pony - mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153 cm (15 hh). Rider 19 years and under.

Class 34 Young Handler - Child 11 years and under. To be shown in hand. Pony will require to be led correctly and presented to judge in halt, walk and trot. **Prizes for all entrants.**

Class 35 Young Handler - Child 12 - 16 years old. To be shown in hand. Pony will require to be led correctly and presented to judge in halt, walk and trot. **Prizes for all entrants.**

EMMA McMIKEN TROPHY FOR BEST SHOW AND SHOW HUNTER PONY from winners of classes 25, 26, 30, 31, 32 and 33.

CKHDT TROPHY FOR BEST TURNED OUT - 1st in classes 1 and 22.

CHAMPIONSHIP - To be judged from 1st prize winners in classes 17-35. **BILL WHITEHALL TROPHY**

SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIP - Champion and Reserve from Rings 1 & 2.

PERPETUAL TROPHY - THE DR JOHN CALVERT MEMORIAL TROPHY

Classes may clash and will not be held up for competitors in another ring.
